GDPR- How we use your data

This notice is to help you understand how and why we collect personal information about you and what we do with that information. It also explains the decisions that you can make about your own information.

What is personal information?

Personal information is information that identifies you as an individual and relates to you. This includes your contact details, next of kin and financial information. If you enrol with us, we may also hold information such as your religion or ethnic group.

Personal information will be stored in a secure and safe manner and electronic data will be protected by passwords, encrypted where necessary.

How long do we keep your information?

We keep your information for as long as you are a student at Bradford Academy.

If you submit an application form, and decide not to enrol with us, your information will be deleted and your application form destroyed.

What decisions can you make about your information?

From May 2018 data protection legislation gives you a number of rights regarding your information.

- If information is incorrect you can ask us to correct it;
- You can ask what information we hold on you and be provided with a copy
- You can ask us to delete the information that we hold about you in certain circumstances. For example, where we no longer need the information;
- You can ask us to send you, or another organisation, certain types of information about you in a format that can be read by computer
