16 – 18 Mathematics and English

These scores show how much progress students at this school or college made in English and Maths qualifications such as GCSE re-takes, between the end of [key stage 4](#) and the end of the [16 to 18 phase of education](#). A positive score means that, on average, students got higher grades at 16 to 18 than at key stage 4. A negative score means that, on average, students got lower grades than at key stage 4.
