Proposed amendment

Assessment of amendment to the Fire Safety policies and procedures due to the reorganised practices and procedures resulting from the impact of the pandemic.

Procedure for Evacuation Fire Safety Policy:

In event of the fire alarm sounding, the Heads or Lead individuals of the Primary and Secondary must contact the fire officer on radio channel 5. Any known information should be shared at this point to enable the fire officer to decide if the alarm can be silenced and reset later, or remain activated until the source is known and then reset once the hazard has been dealt with. The school must be evacuated as normal and the fire officer must ascertain where the alarm has been activated, and from the panel and take appropriate action e.g. reset system, call fire brigade.
