Dear Parents/Carers

I write to inform you of the arrangements with regard to our Post-16 students resuming their learning on site.

Over recent days, we have had professionals review the building and I am pleased to say that the flood damage has not resulted in any major damage which would compromise the health and safety of staff and learners. Whilst not ideal, we will be reverting to a normal timetable to minimise disruption to staff and learners, and then commissioning work to be carried out on the classrooms affected on a rotation basis.

The classrooms affected are being deep cleaned and dehumidified by an external company this week and we anticipate a normal timetable on Monday 20th September.

We are aware that a number of learners are following our **Y12 Access Pathway** and therefore have similar deadlines as our Year 11 learners, therefore we will be inviting these learners into the building from **Thursday 16th September** for some face to face learning. These learners should report to Study Central at 11.00am. **The remainder of our Post-16 learners** should return as per the timetable issued at the start of term on **Monday 20th September**.

We apologise for the disruption and ask for your continued co-operation whilst we deal with the consequences of this unfortunate incident.
